1. **RULES:** Play is governed by the 2012-2015 U.S.G.A. Rules of Golf, and the following Local Rules and Conditions of Competition. Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for a breach of a Local Rule or Condition is Two Strokes.
2. **FORMAT:** 18 Holes of Individual Stroke Play. In the case of **SEVERE WEATHER** or other unusual circumstances, the Committee may declare the **STIPULATED ROUND** will consist of the maximum number of holes completed by all players in each division.
3. The **MAXIMUM SCORE** on any hole is **SIX (X6)**. Players must pick up after 6 strokes.
4. **Players and Caddies** must **WALK** during the stipulated round. See Appendix I.
5. **CADDIES** are prohibited for the 12-14 and 15-18 Age Divisions. See Appendix I.
6. **OUT OF BOUNDS** is defined by the inside points, at ground level, of white stakes and fence posts, and the inside edge of Highway A1A. A ball that is beyond a road is Out of Bounds even though it may lie on another part of the course.
7. All **WATER HAZARDS** are **LATERAL** Water Hazards. For Internal Lateral Water Hazards, Red Stakes indicate the hazard and Red Lines (or where the bank breaks down, if there are no lines) define the margins. The Ocean is a Lateral Water Hazard with the margin defined by the inside edge of the bushes. The Intracoastal Waterway is a Lateral Water Hazard with the margin defined by the inside edge of the bushes and/or the seawall.
8. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR** includes areas encircled by white lines, Fire Ant Beds, French Drains, newly Trenched Areas, Sod Seams, and Flower Beds with flowers.
9. The **EMBEDDED BALL** Rule is in effect Through the Green. See Appendix I.
10. Areas of **COQUINA** and **SHELL** are **Through the Green**, not bunkers or obstructions.
11. Players may obtain distance information by using a device that measures **DISTANCE ONLY**. See Appendix I.
12. **SUSPENSION OF PLAY** for a **Dangerous Situation** will be signaled by a long blast of an air horn. Players must discontinue play immediately. See Appendix I.
13. Players must play within the **PACE OF PLAY** guidelines established by the Committee. Groups out of position will be timed and are subject to penalty.
14. **SCORE CARDS** must be returned to the Scoring Table near the Scoreboard immediately after completion of play. All players in a group should come to the Scoring Table together.
15. Weather and Time permitting, **TIES** for First Place will be decided by a sudden death play-off immediately following play. Any ties not decided in a play-off will be broken by matching score cards as specified in Appendix I.
